

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

BLEZEL TORREGOSA, #106,530
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect April 19, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, Blezel Torregosa, #106,530 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- Between October 2023 and January 2024, the Registrant failed to ensure confidentiality and privacy when they accessed the personal health care records of an excessive number of patients where there was no care relationship.
- On one (1) occasion in January 2024, the Registrant failed to maintain confidentiality and privacy when they accessed the personal health care records of a co-worker where was no care relationship and for purposes inconsistent with their professional responsibilities.

The Registrant must pay a \$2,500.00 fine and shall be suspended for thirty (30) days. The Registrant is required to provide a letter at four (4) and nine (9) months from their employer confirming a privacy audit has been conduct and there are no further privacy breaches. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
