

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

CORINNE DRIEDGER, #96,107
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
also known as **College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **May 2, 2023**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, CORINNE DRIEDGER, #96,107 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- In 2022, the Registrant failed to practice with honesty, integrity and respect, and failed to follow one (1) or more employer policies, when they destroyed health information and/or documents provided for in-services, and removed documents from their work computer that should have been left with the employer.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework on professionalism in nursing and provide a fine in the amount of \$250.00. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
